- Toilet Paper Roll
- Paint
- · Clean Can
- Fun Patch
- Toy Car
- Wood or Foam Star Shape
- Glue Gun
- Name Tag
- Markers
- Star Ornament

#### **Girl Powered Derby Trophy**

- Clean Can
- Water Bottle
- Scissors
- Garland
- Bottle Cap
- Small Wooden Dowels or Chop Sticks
- Fun Patch
- Wood or Foam Star Shape
- Name Tag

## Let's get creative

### **Pinewood Derby Trophy**

Paint your toilet paper roll and allow to dry before moving onto these next steps.





- Using the glue gun, glue your funpatch to the wooden/foam star. Next, once dry, glue the toilet paper roll to the center of the can. Glue the toy car to the top, the star ornament to the front, and the wooden/foam star with the patch to the top of the front of the can.
- 3 Use marker to label your name tag and stick to the front of the can.

### **Girl Powered Derby Trophy**

Use your scissors to cut the top off of a plastic water bottle. Hot glue this, cap-side down to the top of the can. Use the scissors again to cut up the garland and then glue the pieces to the chopsticks. Glue these at the base and place them inside the water bottle.

# **Instructions Continued**

- Hot Glue the fun patch to the wood/foam star, and then glue the star to the end of another dowel/chopstick. Glue the chopstick into the water bottle like you did with the garland-wrapped ones.
- Hot glue the bottle cap to the base of the waterbottle. If you would like, decorate this piece, or find one that already looks fun.
- Use marker to label your name tag and stick to the front of the can.
